## CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

## BY-LAW NO. 21-14

Being a By-Law to appoint a Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officer and Animal Control Officer, and Fix the Terms of Such Employment.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, Section 283 provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of all municipalities for appointing such officers and employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the Corporation or for carrying into effect any Act of the Legislature or by-law of the Council.

AND WHEREAS Section 15 of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.P. 16 provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and such Municipal By-law Enforcement Officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson to appoint a By-Law Enforcement Officer and Animal Control Officer.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson enacts as follows:

- 1. That James M. Mahoney is hereby appointed as By-law Enforcement Officer and Animal Control Officer effective immediately, to serve at the pleasure of Council
- 2. The position of Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer and Animal Control Officer shall be considered a contract position and therefore will not be entitled to any other benefits of the Municipality except solely for those as stipulated in the attached Contract Agreement. The terms shall be as set out in the agreement annexed hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this By-Law.
- 3. James M. Mahoney shall be deemed to be an officer and representative of the Municipal Corporation when acting in the scope of his duties.

Read a First, Second and Third time, signed and the seal of the Corporation affixed thereto, and finally passed in Council this  $1^{\rm st}$  day of April, 2014.
