

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

BY-LAW # 6-12

BEING A BY-LAW RESPECTING REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES FOR MEMBERS OF COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act 2001, Section 283 provides that a council of a municipality may by by-law provide for remuneration and expenses and payment thereof for its members, officers and employees of the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS the said Act provides for expenses and allowance to be established by the Council of a municipality and for expenses to be paid to officers and employees of the Corporation:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson enacts as follows:

1. That the remuneration for the Reeve shall be \$125.00 per meeting.
2. That the remuneration for Councillors shall be \$100.00 per meeting.
3. That travel be paid at the current rate per kilometre for meetings attended.
4. That meal allowance will be paid as actually incurred and supported by receipts. No alcohol included in invoices, or on the corporate credit card.
5. That accommodation be paid as actually incurred and supported by receipts;
6. That registration be paid as actually incurred and supported by receipts;
7. That, as per Resolution # 9, passed on January 13, 2004 one third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of the Council and its local boards shall continue as expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as members of the Council or local board;
8. That all by-laws, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed;
9. Attendance at conferences and training sessions must be authorized by Council resolution. Members of Council attending training seminars and conferences will be entitled to the meeting rate. Partners in attendance at conferences will be at their own cost. Meal expenses for partners in attendance shall be paid personally, not on the corporate credit card.
10. Anyone wishing to sit on the executive of an external organization, that involves a cost to the municipality, must first obtain authorization from Council.

11. For any use of the Corporate credit cards, receipts must be turned in to the municipal office.

12. That this by-law comes into effect on the day of passing.
