UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Deputy Clerk Nancy Field provided a staff report to Council, outlining a letter to property owners within the floodplain. Information for disposing of the 2019 flood waste and a waste disposal voucher was recommended for Council approval and a resolution was adopted as noted below.

2019 DRAFT BUDGET

Treasurer Brayden Robinson reviewed line changes to the 2019 draft budget and several questions were raised by Council. The levy increase is 3.99%.

A member of the public, Paul Van Dam provided his comments on the budget expenditures, expressing concern about the percentage increase.

Council discussed the proposed budget and directed the Treasurer to provide this draft as the final draft at the June 4, 2019 meeting.
