BY-LAW # 35-12

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT A MUNICIPAL ACCESSIBILITY PLAN**

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario passed the Ontarians with Disabilities Act (ODA) on December 14, 2001 and proclaimed additional sections of the act on September 30, 2002, and Accessibility Standards for Customer Service (Ontario Regulation 429/07).

WHEREAS the Act sets out accessibility obligations for municipalities and all municipalities are required to develop annual accessibility plans and make them public.

WHEREAS each year, the Council of every municipality will prepare an accessibility plan and either get advice from its accessibility advisory committee or consult with people with disabilities and others if the Council doesn't have an accessibility advisory committee,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Township of Ryerson does hereby adopt the Municipal Accessibility Plan attached hereto.
