

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

BY-LAW # 7-11

BEING A BY-LAW TO EXTEND INTERIM CONTROL
BY-LAW 6-10, TO IMPOSE INTERIM CONTROLS ON
DEVELOPMENT AND CHANGES OF USE DURING
A STUDY ON THE USES TO BE PERMITTED AND ZONING
AND OTHER REGULATIONS WHICH SHOULD BE IN
EFFECT IN THE PROPOSED MAGNETAWAN RIVER
FLOODPLAIN AREA.

WHEREAS the Municipality has authority under Section 38 (1), of the Planning Act to impose interim controls on land use during the term of a review or study of what permanent zoning and other land use controls should be in place in a defined part of the Municipality and such study has been authorized by a separate by-law;

AND WHEREAS The Municipality has authority to extend the period of such by-law to up to two years from the date of initial passage;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson enacts as follows:

1. CITATION AND SCHEDULES: This By-law shall be cited as the "Ryerson Proposed Magnetawan Floodplain Interim Control By-law" First Extension By-law.
2. All Provisions of By-law 6-10 shall remain in force to and including the 6th day of April, 2011. Council reserves the right to further extend interim controls beyond that date.
