

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

BY-LAW # 7 - 14

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PASSING OVER A BRIDGE.

WHEREAS Chapter H8, Section 123, subsection 2 of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1990) provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may by By-Law limit the gross weight of any vehicle;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson deems it expedient to limit the weight of vehicles passing over a bridge in the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson enacts as follows:

1. No vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class thereof, whether empty or loaded, shall be operated over the bridge located on Midlothian Road at Lot 24, Concession 10 in the Corporation of the Township of Ryerson with a Gross Vehicle Weight exceeding 11, 20 and 28 tonnes for single unit vehicles, two-unit vehicles and vehicle trains respectively.
2. Any person violating the provisions of this By-Law shall be subject to the penalties in Section 125 of the Highway Traffic Act.
3. School buses, Emergency Service Vehicles and Municipal Maintenance Vehicles, including municipal contractors, are exempt from this by-law. However, reduced loads and alternate routes will be encouraged when possible.
4. This By-Law shall not become effective until a notice of the limit of weight permitted, legibly printed, has been posted in a conspicuous place at each end of the bridge.

Read a First, Second, and Third time, Signed, and the Seal of the Corporation affixed thereto and finally passed in Council this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 2014.
