

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

BY-LAW # 8-12

Being a By-Law to confirm the proceedings of Council at its meetings

January 3, 10, 17, 24, 2012 and February 7 and 21, 2012.

WHEREAS Section 5(3) of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 24, as amended, requires a municipal Council to exercise its powers by By-Law, except where otherwise required;

AND WHEREAS Council or a Committee of Council often authorizes action to be taken which does not lend itself to an individual By-Law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Ryerson deems it desirable to confirm the proceedings of Council at its meeting hereinafter set out.

BE IT ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Ratification and Confirmation
